Chamber program, Smart Commute Central York has completed its two-year Active School Travel (AST) pilot program in Newmarket, having conducted 36 on-site student events, and over 109 site visits. Student active travel rates are now around 50% higher than driving rates, and these stats don't include busing data. The program will soon be expanded to include additional schools.
